The requirement for the biometric registration is a BVN (if available) and any of the following listed original/valid supporting documents.

- 2. Driver's License
- 3. Voter's card (Temporary or Permanent)
- 4. Nigerian International passport
- 5. Certificate of Origin (obtainable from any Local Government in Nigeria)
- 6. Attestation letter from a prominent ruler in your community
- 7. Birth certificate
- 8. Declaration of age
- 9. Attestation letter from religious/traditional leader
- 10. NHIS ID card
- 11. Government staff ID card
- 12. Registered/recognized private organization staff ID card
- 13. School ID Card (private/public)
- 14. Tax Clearance certificate
- 15. Valid immigration documents
- 16. Nigerian Commission for Refugees (NCFR) Refugee Certificate
- 17. Refugee ID card
- 18. Refugee Factsheet

Appendix 2

Section 27 of the NIMC Act 2007. —(1) As from the date specified in that regard in regulations made by the Commission, the National Identification Number issued to a registered individual must be presented for the following transactions, that is:

- (c) application for, and issuance of a passport;
- (b) opening of individual and or personal bank accounts;
- (c) purchase of insurance policies;
- (d) subject to the provisions of the Land Use Act, the purchase, transfer and registration of land by any individual or any transaction connected therewith;
- (e) such transactions pertaining to individuals as may be prescribed and regulated by the Pensions Reform Act, 2004;
- (f) such transactions specified under the Contributory Health Insurance Scheme;
- (g) such transactions that have social security implications;
- (h) all consumer credit transactions;
- (i) registration of voters;
- (i) payment of taxes;
- (k) such relevant government services
